Minutes of General Meeting
7 PM, David Crohan Community Center, 655 Flanders Road, Flanders
July 13, 2015

1. The meeting was called to order at 7:05 pm
2. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and the June Treasurer's report read and accepted.
3. The Roll was called: Vincent Taldone, Larry Carnevale, Lona Muldrow and Steven Schreiber in attendance. Patty Hopkins absent. Minutes to be taken by Vince Taldone.
4. Announcements: Blood Drive /School Supply Drive
5. Correspondence: Letter from FRNCA to Congressman Zeldin requesting three hamlet zip codes.
6. Guest Speaker, District Director for Congressman Lee Zeldin, Mark Woolley, asked for input from members and guests regarding need for hamlet specific zip codes. Members' primary reasons for need cited including misdirected mail and medicine deliveries, lost visitors, incorrect real estate listings, delayed emergency service arrivals and sense of identity within Town of Southampton. Carl Iacone and others recounted the long history of requesting separate zip codes.
7. Guest Speaker, LI Central Pine Barrens Commission, John Pavacic, explained proposed mechanical and controlled burn plans for sections of PB west and south of FRN hamlets. Reasons for need to reduce fuel load and other environmental benefits described. Members suggested the need for additional work to reduce wildfire risk in future. Fire Chief Pettit agreed. Present plan paid for by \$250,00 NYS funds.
8. Guest Speaker, Riverside Rediscovered, Siris Barrios, updated members on proposed zoning review which is on schedule to be reviewed and approved by town at end of this year.
9. Many school supplies were delivered to the meeting by members and taken by President Taldone for delivery to Phillips Avenue Elementary School. FRNCA board approves motion by president, purchase additional supplies which will be done by president.
